Subject: AICTE approval to Gangamai Education Trust's Gangamai College of Engineering, Nagaon, Dhule for conduct of Engineering Degree courses.

Sir,

I am directed to state that on consideration of the recommendations made by the AICTE Task Force for Maharashtra State, the All India Council for Technical Education has accorded conditional approval to the Gangamai Education Trust's Gangamai College of Engineering, Nagaon, Dhule, Maharashtra to conduct the following full time degree courses for two academic years (1993-94 and 1994-95) with annual intake shown against each:

S.No.	Name of the Course	Intake
1.	Mechanical Engineering	60 (Sixty)
2.	Electronics & Tele-Comm. Engg.	60 (Sixty)
3.	Instrumentation Engg.	60 (Sixty)

The approval is subject to fulfilment of the specific and general conditions given below:

- (1) One Professor and two Assistant Professors must be appointed by 1.1.1993 for each discipline.
- (2) 10% of the faculty must be given opportunity for upgradation of qualifications/professional development.
- (3) Various laboratories must be strengthened with additional equipment.
- (4) A qualified Principal must be appointed as per AICTE norms and guidelines.
- (5) The Management including the Governing Body of the Institution shall be constituted and the Chairman shall be appointed as per the guidelines of the AICTE.
- (6) No new courses shall be started or an on-going course shall be discontinued by the institution without the prior approval of the AICTE.

- (7) The intake in any year shall not be altered without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- (8) Adequate funds shall be available with the institution to meet the financial obligations of recurring and non-recurring nature including endowment fund, as prescribed by the AICTE.
- (9) All infrastructural, instructional and other facilities shall be provided as per AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.
- (10) Teaching and other staff shall be selected according to the procedure, qualifications, experience and pay scales as prescribed by AICTE from time to time, and that they shall be paid full salaries and allowances regularly and in time.
- (11) The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria/limits prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
- (12) The institution shall not charge any capitation fee or donation for admission or other higher charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form.
- (13) Admissions shall be made on merits and as per the norms and guidelines of the AICTE.
- (14) The State Government policies for admissions of SC/ST, other weaker sections of Society etc. shall be followed by the Institution.
- (15) Institution by virtue of the approval of the AICTE shall not automatically become eligible to receive financial grants or assistance from the Central or State Government.
- (16) Institution shall maintain records and books of accounts as prescribed by the Competent Authority.
- (17) The accounts of the Institution shall be audited by Chartered Accountant or any agency authorised by the Competent Authority and shall be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorised by it.
- (18) The institution shall be subject to a Special Audit and inspection as prescribed by the AICTE.
- (19) Institution shall furnish requisite returns as prescribed to Competent Authority/AICTE for ensuring maintenance of standards.
- (20) The Institution may be visited by an officer or a Committee of the AICTE or of its Regional Office from time to time to review the progress made by the Institution in fulfilling the conditions as laid down by the AICTE.

- (ii) The institution shall constitute a Planning and Monitoring Board (PMB) for the continuous monitoring of implementation of norms and standards of the AICTE. There shall be an evaluation of the institution in a plan period by the AICTE.
- (iii) The institution must submit a duly registered undertaking on non-judicial stamp paper towards fulfilment of conditions in the standard format.

In the event of non-compliance of the guidelines, norms and standards prescribed by the AICTE, the AICTE shall be free to take measures for withdrawal of the approval without consideration of any related issues and that liabilities arising out of such withdrawal would be solely that of the Trust/Society and/or the institution.

This approval is further subject to full compliance with the judgement as prescribed by the Supreme Court in its judgement dated 12.1.1993 on W.P.(C) No. 607 of 1992 with other WPs in the case of Thirukrishnan, I.P. and others etc. etc. vs State of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. etc. and the related guidelines and criteria as may be issued by the AICTE, UGC or the Central Government from time to time.

You are requested to kindly take necessary action to implement the decision of the AICTE and communicate the progress made in this regard to the Western Regional Committee (WRC) of the AICTE under intimation to this Office.
